PRIVACY NOTICE

I am a full-time law professor based in Washington, D.C. who does not serve as a barrister or solicitor in the United Kingdom. As an associate member of Matrix Chambers, I occasionally serve as counsel, expert or arbitrator principally for inter-State or investor-State disputes. As such, my practice mostly does not involve the use of personal data and any such data typically is processed in the United States and not by Matrix Chambers. However, to the extent that I receive personal data (such as contact details), I may provide it to Matrix Chambers, in which case it is possible that Matrix Chambers would be a “data processor” and I would be the “controller” of the data within the meaning of the U.K. Data Protection Act 2018.

The legal bases for any personal data processing that I carry out, under applicable U.S. or U.K. data protection laws, are that the processing: is necessary for the legitimate interests pursued by me in the course of my work as counsel, expert or arbitrator; is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which I am subject; and/or has been consented to by the data subject. I will not keep any personal data for longer than is necessary for the purposes set out in this notice or as required by law.

For data falling within the scope of U.K. data protection legislation, you have the following rights:

- the right to be informed about the collection and use of your personal data
- the right of access to your personal data, and the right to request a copy of the information that I hold about you and supplementary details about that information
- the right to have inaccurate personal data that I process about you rectified
- in certain circumstances, the right to have personal data that I process about you blocked, erased or destroyed (right of erasure)
- the right to object to, or restrict the processing of personal data concerning you for direct marketing, and continued processing of your personal data
- in certain circumstances, the right of portability of your data
