NOTABLE CASES

Recent cases involving crime, including fraud and terrorism:

R v Sanders and others (2012) - Cross-jurisdictional insider-trading allegations brought by the Financial Services Authority.

Prosecutor v Ruto and others (2011) - Successful defence of former chairman of Kenyan opposition party in International Criminal Court.

HH and PH v Deputy Prosecutor of Genoa (2012) - Supreme Court appeal on significance of children's Article 8 rights on extradition of parents.

R v Barkshire and others (2011) - Successful appeal of 20 environmental protestors overturned on appeal after public revelations about undercover officer, Mark Kennedy.

R v Dizaei (2011) - Successful appeal of senior, high-profile police officer accused of perverting course of justice.

ADI v Roberts (2011) - Representing NGO in private prosecution against circus owners for cruelty to an elephant.

R v Subramaniam (2010) - \$1bn fraud involving certificates of deposit.

R v E-T (2010) - Breach of trade sanctions, involving challenge to vires of statutory instrument.

Mann v SOCA (2010) - Appeared for Fair Trials Abroad in high profile extradition case.

R v Tharan (2009) - Defence of businessmen over alleged provision of electronics expertise to Tamil Tigers in Sri Lanka.

R v S and A (2008) - First challenge to RIPA Part III, requirement to provide encryption codes.

R v Khyam and others (2008) - Leading counsel in Operation Crevice ("Fertiliser Bomb Plot") both at trial and appeal.

R v Barot and others - Leading counsel in "Dirty Bomb" and "New York banks" plot.

R v Abdullah and others (2007) - Leading counsel in first prosecution relating to publishing material under the Terrorism Act 2006.

R v Sihali and others (2005) and (2008) - "Ricin" trial, and subsequent SIAC proceedings following client's acquittal.

Trimingham v Daily Mail (2012) – Lead counsel for Carina Trimingham in her claim of harassment and breach of privacy by the Daily Mail.

R v Barkshire and others (2012) – Advising on civil claims flowing from criminal case (above).

Hizb ut Tahrir v Germany (2012) - ECtHR claim brought by political party against German legislation.

Leveson Inquiry (2011) - Representing several witnesses required to provide evidence relating to phone hacking and media conduct.

Inquest into the death of Ian Tomlinson (2011) - Represented family of newspaper seller Ian Tomlinson who died at time of 2009 G20 protests, resulting in unlawful killing verdict and eventual prosecution of officer concerned.

Naik v Home Secretary (2011) - Challenge to exclusion of leading Indian Muslim preacher and broadcaster, on Article 10 grounds (also appeared in the earlier seminal case on same subject: Farrakhan v Home Secretary (2002)).

Re: Hill (2011) - Representing Guardian journalist required to disclose sources in relation to phone hacking inquiry.

Hizb ut Tahrir v Germany (2010) - ECtHR claim brought by political party against German legislation.

Faisaltext v CC of Lancashire Constabulary (2009) - High Court challenge to seizure and inspection of business materials.

AU v Secretary of State for Home Department (2009) - Control order challenge in relation to Libyans opposed to Ghaddafi regime.

Re: A Bureau de Change (2009) - Judicial review of search warrant relating to seizure of material from Bureau de Change.
